FROM YOUR PASTOR'S HEART

It was exciting . . . to be a part of the worship last Sunday morning. It was good to see the sun two days in a row! It was good to sing praises with God's precious people. Four children were baptized and there was a sense of joy in our midst. God is doing some amazing things during our worship times. If you have missed over the past few weeks due to the "uncertain" weather, I hope you will join us this Sunday. Our Children's Choirs will be helping to lead us this week!

This Sunday begins . . . the Week of Prayer for North American Missions. Our WMU will be offering several opportunities for us to learn about mission work in our country and in Canada. (OK, Canada did take the gold in Olympic hockey from us, but we can still support God's church work there!) I will be leading the Wednesday night study on March 10. We will see how God is working in North America and learn about how the NAMB is organizing to reach people. We will begin to take up money for the Annie Armstrong Mission Offering this week. We will take the offering through Easter. I remind you that every cent given to this offering goes directly to the mission field. (It is as our church gives to the Cooperative Program that we support the administrative costs.) I know you will pray about your support of our mission work here in the US and Canada.

Easter . . . will be here in a few short weeks. Easter Sunday is on Sunday, April 4th this year. After I finish the book of Jonah this coming Sunday, I will be preaching on the cross as we move towards "resurrection Sunday." We will observe the Lord's Supper on Sunday, March 28 (Palm Sunday) as part of our study of the passion of Jesus.

Our Church-wide Renewal Week-end . . . is only a few weeks away. I am so thrilled that Ed Newton will be preaching beginning Friday, April 16 and finishing on Sunday night, April 18. We will eat each night at 5:30 p.m. and have the services at 6:30 p.m. (We will follow our regular Sunday morning schedule.) Ed is a great preacher and evangelist. He has become well known throughout the country as a powerful communicator. He will be leading our church in a time of renewal and recommitment. I am convinced that he is here on God's timing. Be praying for these services and be praying that our church can continue to be used by God to reach this community.

I am praying . . . that we will hit 700 in worship sometime this spring (other than Easter and Mother's Day). That is a significant number for us. When we have 700, we will be close to 90% full in our worship space. We are already out of usable Bible Study space on Sunday morning in the second hour. I want to challenge you to pray for God's leadership as we make decisions about the future. God is blessing and we want to stay in the center of His will!
